The Alignment Nashville Operating Board is supporting MNPS 2013-14 Intersession, which is an integral part of the new balanced calendar with its primary focus on providing extended and enriched learning experiences. The Intersession dates are as follows: October 8-11, 2013 and March 18-21, 2014.

- o Experience MORE (skills): The development of programs and services to extend and enrich the learning experiences of MNPS students. Examples: science camp, young engineers, park exploration, ACT/SAT camps, etc.
- o Do MORE (character): Programs and experiences that promote civic and community involvement and improvement. Examples: health/wellness camps, community service projects, tours, liberal arts programs.

The primary outputs/outcomes supported by this Invitation to Participate (ITP) are:

- o Preparing for post-secondary education (ACT prep, college visits, etc.),
- o Preparing for post-secondary career (internships, work place tours, service learning, etc.)
- o Students maintain academic success (reading, test prep, etc.),
- o Students are physically capable to enter and participate in school

Participating organizations will also receive a final report outlining their contribution to the shared outcomes that can be used for their own reporting and fundraising needs.

MNPS and the Alignment Nashville Operating Board are seeking community partners to provide high-quality programming and resources for students grades K-12 during MNPS Intersession 2013-14 around the following focus areas:

- 1. Career exploration (K-12)
- 2. Reading
- 3. Math
- **4. College/career readiness** (including ACT prep)

- 7. Health (physical & nutrition)
