Committee Vision: All MNPS students and families have the resources they need to promote student achievement. Description: The Social Services Committee was created specifically to support the Social Services pillar of Community Achieves which focuses on four key areas: College and Career Readiness, Family Engagement, Health and Wellness, and Social Services at participating schools. Through Community Achieves, each participating school will assess its needs and work with partners to offer programs focused on the specific needs of their students, parents and community. The overall objective of the Social Services Committee is to build the capacity of MNPS Community Achieves sites and community partners to organize their human and financial resources around student success.

Additionally, the Social Services Committee focus is to create a district-wide framework that aligns social service resources to the specific needs of MNPS students and their families. After taking an in-depth look at school data, the Social Services Committee decided to develop a pilot initiative focused on the Glencliff cluster and Coleman Park Community Center where some success has been reported with working with a high-needs community. The committee's pilot builds on a model used by Catholic Charities and Coleman Park Community Center where a "community movie night" was used as the vehicle to bring families and social service providers together.

This Invitation To Participate ("ITP") is designed to explore the science of providing targeted social services and aligning them to meet the specific needs of MNPS students and families by leveraging Coleman Park's status as a "trust agent" in the community. The pilot will provide the committee with invaluable information on how to (1) build community relationships and develop organization capacity; (2) support targeted community outreach; and (3) engage communities to effectively meet their needs. The results of this pilot will be used to inform other initiatives identified by the committee regarding developing professional development opportunities for social service providers to improve how they target and deliver their services and providing tools for MNPS faculty and staff to better assist their students with meeting their social services needs.
