Project Overview

The Alignment Nashville Middle School Committee is seeking to support Jere Baxter Middle School in their efforts to improve the reading scores of its students. In the latest results from the Tennessee Comprehensive Assessment Program (TCAP), 35% of Jere Baxter students scored below basic in the Reading Language assessment.

Specifically, Jere Baxter has identified 200 students who are 2-3 grade levels behind in reading and seek community support in working with those students to increase their reading skills. Participating organizations will be trained in a five-part research based model. The training is fun, interactive and takes about 1.5 hours. Trained tutors will learn to guide their students through oral reading, discussion, rereading, word study, and writing. Each part of the lesson strengthens a critical component of reading. The lesson format is easy to follow and can be conducted in a 30 minute timeframe.

Project Explanation

General Description

The Alignment Nashville Middle School Committee is seeking to support Jere Baxter Middle School in their efforts to improve the reading scores of its students. According to Dr. Tammy Lipsey, Director of Literacy, MNPS, "Ideally, we would like for our recruited tutors to stay for the entire year but this is not always possible. Through our studies, we have found that students make a reading gain in about 7 lessons. However, we know sustaining this growth takes more reading practice. We recommend at least a semester which is usually 18 weeks. While this is best practice, we are open to any and all tutor schedules. As you know, we need many tutors to close our reading gap."

Target Populations:

Jere Baxter students who:

- Are 2-3 reading grades below grade level;
- Need academic enrichment; and
- Will benefit from an intervention focused around literacy
