The Behavioral Health Committee has identified the following key areas as being timely and pertinent to the staff of MNPS and also to community organizations serving MNPS students This information is critical in gaining an understanding of the importance of SEL:

We are seeking workshops in these 5 key areas (as defined by CASEL) of SEL:

- ♦ Self Awareness: recognizing one's emotions and values as well as one's strengths and limitations.
- Responsible decision-making: making ethical, constructive choices about personal and social behavior
- Relationship skills: forming positive relationships, working in teams, dealing effectively with conflict.
- Social awareness: showing understanding and empathy for others.
- ♦ Self-management: managing emotions and behaviors to achieve one's goals.
- Each seminar will be 60 minutes long, and organizations should be prepared to offer each seminar twice.

- If your organization would like to offer multiple seminars, please complete a separate proposal for each seminar.

  - ♦ **Description of workshop to be delivered**: provide a brief description **(100 words or less)** of your proposed seminar. *This information will be printed in the event program,*
  - Select which topic area are you covering with this workshop (self awareness, relationship skills, etc.)
  - ♦ Describe your organization's expertise in this topic area

Please submit your proposal by **April 1, 2011**. All proposals will be reviewed by the Behavioral Health Committee and you will be notified no later than **April 15, 2011**.
